Payment of Bills: On a motion by Rich Weaver and a second by Ed Kalinowski, it was moved to pay the following bill:

Minutes: The minutes from May 24, 2018 were presented in printed form; on a motion by Kathy O'Neal and a second by Bob Yerkes, the minutes were accepted as printed.

Communications: Letters for re-appointment were received for Ed Kalinowski, Mary Alice Maichle, Patrick Miller and Steve White. Letters to Mid-Sussex and Smyrna Ambulance Associations were sent and there has not been a written response from either organization.

Old Business:

- Bids were received from ESIP and Provident for Accident and Health as well as Accidental Death and Dismemberment policies – all trustees were provided with copies of the plans.
- A bid was received from VFIS for MRA liability insurance the Association will need to review both Selective and VFIS for comparison and a decision to be made at a later date. Patrick Miller will forward the Selective policy to all members to review and compare.

New Business:

- On a motion by Ed Kalinowski and a second by Bob Yerkes, it was moved to recommend at Conference that Provident remain the provider for both A&H and AD&D policies.
- Due to the Accountant's recommendation, it was moved by Rich Weaver and seconded by Bob Yerkes that an increase in dues and burial benefit be made – burial benefit to increase to \$500 per company and dues to \$100 per company – motion carried.
- There was a discussion about having information available prior to Conference – per the request of the membership – budgetary information will be to the Secretary by September 5, 2018 and will be forwarded to Executive Director Warren Jones for dissemination as well as copies will be available at the Conference meeting.
- A discussion was held concerning those companies that have not paid their MRA bill; it was decided that this issue would be put on hold until after September, as this will be a topic of discussion that those companies not wishing to belong to MRA needs to communicate that to the MRA. This information will then need to be communicated officially to Provident.
